

DESCRIBE THE PRESENT AND ORIGINAL (IF KNOWN) PHYSICAL APPEARANCE

The Blake-Beaty-Orton House in Jasper, Texas, is a two-story Victorian house with a dramatic portico on the entrance or west facade. The house rests on piers of handmade bricks and is made entirely of the native pine including the beveled siding shingles, of different shapes, vertical beaded siding as well as various ornamentations. The roof covering is now corrugated tin but was originally wood shingles. The original windows are narrow and contain 2/2 lights.

The complex pattern of roof planes with intersecting turret as well as the contrasting textures and the irregular plan are unified by the dominant entrance bay consisting of a gable resting on two elongated Roman columns—a portico of dramatic scale. Contrasting with this portico is the more conventional system of wrap around, one—story galleries with turned balustrades, slender turned posts, punched brackets and spandrels. The overlapping and combination of the two is a unique and arresting feature of this house. This manipulation of scale is an excellent example of the form in architecture not being wholly dependent on technology. The gable contains an elaborate bargeboard consisting of an intricate fan and delicate leaf and floral cut—outs and pendants—a tracerty—like design producing an array of shadows on the shingled surface. The fan is outlined by a simple molding with half—round terminations.

That portion of the second floor gallery over the main entrance projects slightly as if it was an isolated balcony, adding to the spatial sensation. These galleries have handsome newel posts, balusters and spindle friezes supported by brackets. The resultant rhythm adds greatly to the richness of the composition. A half turret with a conical roof supported by brackets projects from the wall at the second level on the north side of the portico.

The frieze of the portico is supported by carved brackets terminated by pendants on either side of a dentil-like ornament. The bargeboard with fan occurs in a gable on each of the north and south facades.

A one-story addition at the rear or east is not original. The first level of the house contains parlors on either side of a vestibule. To the rear of the vestibule is the main hall with staircase, dining, sitting room and kitchen. The second level contains 5 bedrooms and a bath.

The Blake-Beaty-Orton House is a Victorian house built in the latter part of the nineteenth century. It is an excellent example of the complex design of this period with contrasting shapes, textures, and soilds and voids and is notable for the daring portico design.

_INDUSTRY

_INVENTION

Claims have been made that the house was constructed as early as the 1860's but all records to substantiate such a claim were in the County Courthouse which burned in the middle 1880's. From an architectural history view, the house should be dated in the 1880's and it appears in photographic records and writing after T. J. Beaty had acquired the property in 1888. This would be consistent with similar Victorian house designs in Texas.

The Beaty family owned the property on which the house stands as early as 1843. After being owned briefly by Stephen Williams, grandson and namesake of a veteran of both the American Revolution and the Texas Revolution, the property was acquired by the G.W. Blake family. Mr. Blake was by profession a carpenter and cabinetmaker. His daughter claimed to have been born in the house in 1861 and Blake was a "trained artisan" with manually driven machines such as planes and lathes to duplicate such elaborate turnings. However, no record supports the claim.

G. W. Blake died in 1882 and later his widow sold the property to J. T. Beaty, son of the earlier Beaty, a prominent citizen of Jasper who studied law and became an attorney. He was elected Senator from the 14th District to the Texas Legislature from 1901 to 1906. The size and grandeur of the home lends itself to Mr. Beaty's advanced station and it more likely the house was constructed after he acquired the property. Marguerite Beaty Orton, daughter of J.T. Beaty and the occupant of the house until 1973, has given the property to the city of Jasper, which plans to restore the structure. It is one of the last remaining 19th century houses and the most impressive in Jasper.




