DESCRIPTION: 2-story frame res. w/ low pitched roof, bracketed overhanging eaves, front bay windows & front side porches with wood arched brackets. Some Italianate detailing in pedimented architraves, front door has etched glass and silver hardware.

SIGNIFICANCE: A.A. Erhard built the house in 1870 and lived there until his death in 1899. Born in Germany Erhard in 1831, Erhard came to Texas in 1839. His parents died of yellow fever and was left orphaned. He eventually became one of Bastrop's most prominent citizens. The house displays Italianate influences and is one of the most outstanding Victorian homes in Bastrop.
