DESCRIPTION Brick church with long nave flanked by towers: one of three stories, the other a taller bell tower whose pinnacle is topped with a small stone cross. Ground-floor front facade of stone, as is trim on towers and windows. Three Romanesque arches on recessed front entrance; small arched windows at base and top of towers. Gabled nave ends surmounted by small stone crosses. Lateral gable roof at rear. Good stained glass throughout.

SIGNIFICANCE Building is significant because of its fine stonework detailing. Church was organized in 1908 and met in Fraternal Hall. As the years passed, two school buildings and two church buildings were built on this site before the present building was raised in 1926.
