DESCRIPTION Two-story, L-shaped frame house; intersecting bellcast gable roofs with projecting gable-end bay at front of house (end with patterned shingles and two fancy windows with many quarrels); attached one-floor porch wraps to one side, supported by thin, Ionic columns with entablature above; central front window has leaded glass transom above single pane; single front door, to side, with oval glass light; windows commonly with one-over-one lights; house supported by brick piers with lattice between.

Building material: wall frame, clapboard roof composition

Physical condition good-significant site: original or moved date

Alterations minor alterations to doorway; house is being restored

SIGNIFICANCE House is good example of its type, and preserves its original detail. Many of the structures on Yale Street, on which lot is located, have been razed or fairly extensively altered by commercial developments.

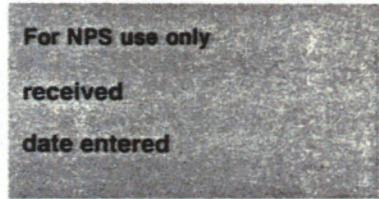
