

Henry P. Mansfield built the fine house, then sold it to S. Allen Kincaide, who later sold it to Alexander Peddie of the Peddie Land Co. The house is one of few remaining in the Heights of this elaborate style, once seen in several homes along the Boulevard and on prominent corners of the Heights.
