Steel supports and reinforced concrete. Significance U.S. National Bank is a major financial institution in Galveston and traces its history back to 1874, with founding of Island City Savings Bank. In 1902, Kempner family bought controlling interest and changed name to Texas Bank and Trust Co., present name adopted in 1923. In 1971, a registered bank holding company acquired majority ownership of U.S. National Bank. Building was described as third modern, skyscraper, office building in Galveston. Blossom was engineer and architect trained in London; designed Magnolia Building in Dallas. U.S. National Bank Building represents a major financial and architectural landmark in Galveston.
