1206 Canterbury is an early twentieth-century shotgun house which is both typical and classic regarding the tradition of its architectural typology. ported by brick piers, this board-and-batten wood-frame structure has a hipped roof and a simple front porch. The house is oriented with its length at right angles to the street; the porch covers a central front door which is surmounted by a transom. Porch columns are turned and support a bracketed cornice. Boards and battens rise to a continuous frieze board overhung by a projecting eave trimmed with stock moulding typical of the period. The boards are simple "one-by" lumber while the battens are milled pieces with finely detailed edges.

### Significance:

Areas of Significance: Architecture

1206 Canterbury is one of the best examples of an architectural type which once was prolific in East Austin, but which has rapidly disappeared in recent years. Despite the fact that the house was constructed as rental property and owned by a number of speculators, the original builder appears to have expended unusual care in the execution of decorative wood details and general carpentry work.
