#10. Description (cont'd): entrance on front porch with two-light transom with segmental arch; one-story, two-bay porch with shed roof within west elevation; Doric columns. Other noteworthy features include one-story five-sided bay projecting from north ell; paired 2/2 windows above bay projection, carved wood pediment above these windows; two-story ell extending from north end of east (rear) elevation; angled corner with pendant and sunburst brackets at northeast corner of rear ell; single-door entrance on north side of ell; two-light transom with segmental arch above door; floral design and "M. Harrell" etched into glass light on door; one-story frame addition on south side of rear ell.

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#12. Significance (cont'd): J. W. Whittle. owned the Whittle and Harrell Lumber Co. which stood at the southeast corner of Timber and Locust (9th) streets. Harrell eventually left the firm and, along with C. S. Belford, bought the Irvine Lumber Co. in 1890. which evolved into the Belford Lumber Co.
