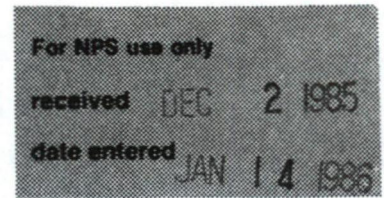

#10. Description (cont'd): with transom; three-bay porch with gable roof over central bay and shed roof over side bays; porch extends across east elevation; turned wooden posts with jigsaw brackets. Other noteworthy features include symmetrical three-bay facade; imbricated shingled gable ends on front porch and southern elevation; jigsaw bargeboards in each gable end; single-door entrance on southern elevation; rear frame additions. Outbuildings include small frame garage.
