Description (cont'd): with corbeled cap; double-hung windows with 6/6 and 2/2 lights; single-door primary entrance with transom in frame addition; porch with gable extension at southwest corner extends across much of west elevation; turned wood posts with slat-wood balustrade and spindled frieze. The original two-room stone house comprises the north portion of present configuration; full basement with access from the north side (and protected by garage addition) under the westernmost room of stone portion; the original front faced south with two, single-door entries; finely crafted quoins around doors and windows; frame addition with shingled gable end on south; angled corners with jigsawn brackets, pendants and turned wood spindles on ground floor; asbestos shingle


