Other noteworthy features include imbricated shingle siding on second-story porch spandrel; hexagonal turret at southeast corner; two-story porch on northwest corner with turned wooden posts, pilasters, and balustrade; pent roofs on gables with composition shingles. Outbuildings include two wood-frame barns, several frame sheds. Prominent interior features include intact woodwork: several mantels, cabinetry, doors, balustrade, etc. in excellent condition.
