Other noteworthy features include three-bay symmetrical north elevation with minor Neoclassical Revival influence; hip dormer with balcony; window bay projects on the west; tripartite "picture" windows flanking north entry have diamond-pattern "transom and sidelights"; shingled foundation wall.
