

#10. Description, continued: hung windows with 1/1 lights; single-door main entrance with transom and sidelights; one-story five-bay porch with hip roof across south and east elevations; Ionic columns. Other noteworthy features include portico with shingle facing at front entry; symmetrical five-bay facade; denticulated cornice on roof and porch; stone lintels above windows; main entry with beveled leaded-glass lights in door and sidelights; some operable wood shutters remain; others were used to construct a playhouse, that is in poor condition, to the rear (north) of the house; one-story section at northwest corner of house might have been the original dwelling; weatherboard siding and wood-pegged 6/6 windows; hall-parlor plan; early 1900s frame

#10. Description (cont'd): addition at northeast corner of house; stone rubble at west end of lot; property includes entire block which is surrounded by a stone-lined fence base; concrete hitching post with iron ring and inscribed with "R. T. Cooper" at front yard; two metal storage buildings and a gazebo made of old license plates on grounds.

#12. Significance (cont'd): 1st National Bank of Georgetown and also helped to establish both Georgetown College and the Georgetown Railroad Co. House was owned later by R. T. and Corrina Taylor Cooper. He worked as a cashier at bank and later was jeweler and real estate agent in Georgetown. House still owned by direct descendants of original owners. Belford Lumber Co. made extensive remodelings in 1910.
