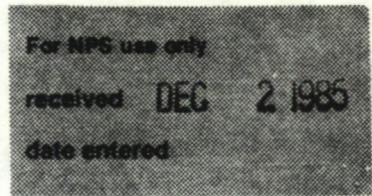

Description (cont'd): single-door entrance; one-story L-shaped porch with three bays on south elevation and two bays on east elevation; Ionic columns support porch; denticulated cornice on porch gables on south and east elevations with inset balcony; gable on south elevation with elliptical arch opening and wooden slat balustrade; imbricated shingles in gable ends; wooden slat balustrade on balcony above porch; small curved-gabled extension on east side of front gable provides access to balcony; gable in east elevation with three-bay inset balcony and fixed oval window with floral designed base in projecting sill in gable that extends from east side to facade. Other noteworthy features include wooden slat balustrade; entry by way of single door at angled corner at southeast corner; stone pier foundation. Outbuildings include modern garage.
