

Description (cont'd): entrance with transom and sidelights; porch with shed roof L-shape in south and east elevations; three bays on each elevation; fluted composite columns and turned-wood balustrade. Other noteworthy fetures include brick foundation wall; attic dormer and upper sashes of ground-floor windows with geometric design; gables with wood-shingle facing and jig-sawn barge boards; three-sided window bay on west elevation. Outbuildings include wood-frame garage.
