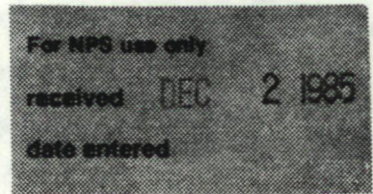

Outbuildings include a small frame garage with board-and-batten construction.
