Description continued: wood balusters; shingled supports; interior brick chimney; large triangular braces, shingle sheathing and second floor balcony suggest a "Swiss chalet." Extended rafter ends, porch supports, and fenestration typical of bungalow type; side porch screened. Early or original exterior color scheme has survived.

Significance continued: bungalow. This was the home of G. G. Dunkerly in the 1920s and 1930s. He was president and manager of Ennis Tag and Printing Co. (United Publishing Co.) and a member of a pioneer Ennis family.
