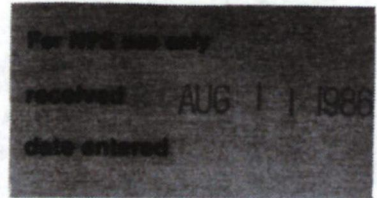

Description continued: shingled box supports; interior and exterior brick chimneys; shingled wood supports on shingled solid porch balustrade; typical bungalow details include mixture of wall cladding; wide overhanging eaves; extended rafter ends, triangular brackets and multiple roof planes.

horizontal massing, multiple roof planes, and overhanging eaves are emphasized. Roy Connally hired W. W. Walston to build the house in 1911. Connally served as secretary of the Retail Merchants Association and Chamber of Commerce. He lived in the house into the 1950s.
