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

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Solon, John, House (Site No. 1963) - 617 Solon Road

Description:

All five buildings in the Solon House complex are considered contributing.

The structure labeled on the site plan as "First Dwelling" is a two-story structure that stands to the north of the main house. It features a hip roof and single rooms on each floor. It rests upon a raised foundation and it is currently used for storage purposes.

The other outbuildings indicated on the site plan are all of board-and-batten construction with gable roofs. They were built in the early twentieth century, and relatively few changes have affected their integrity.

Significance:

The 1894 Solon House is of particular note as a substantial, rural residence reflecting Romanesque stylistic influence. Both style and materials are most often associated with larger city, commercial and institutional buildings in Texas, and their use in the Solon House is exceptional.

All of the associated outbuildings shown on the site plan are at least 50 years old and remain functional structures within this rural complex. Because they are virtually unaltered, all are regarded as contributing elements. The most significant is the structure labeled "First Dwelling." According to the current owner, it was erected in the 1880s and served as John Solon's residence while he was building the main house. The other structures were built in the early twentieth century, and their historic and current functions are listed on the site plan for identification purposes. In addition to extant buildings on the grounds, historic landscaping features are noted and also contribute to the historic character of the site.


