Vandenberg, a graduate of the University of Texas Law School who served as county attorney and district attorney. Vandenberg eventually became a principal in the law firm of Proctor, Vandenberg, Crain and Mitchell. He was also a member of the Board of Directors of Victoria Bank & Trust. Vandenberg's wife died in 1920 and in 1921 he remarried and moved to 604 N. Craig (N.R. site no. I-452).

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
