12. Significance An outstanding Classical Revival design, this became the home to Bryan's First National Bank in 1919. This is one of the most intact commercial buildings in town and among the best local examples of the Classical Revival style.

Description continued: ground-floor openings; two-story round-arched openings w/ voussoirs; wood-sash windows w/ 6/9 lights; 6-light rounded transoms and sidelights; stone and brick parapet w/ molded coping on stepped portion over entry; frieze has "First National Bank" inscribed below denticulated, projecting, stone, cornice molding; ashlar is precisely cut as well as stone details like the entry, cartouche, paterae-adorned door surround and molded string course; indented courses on brick of N. wall correspond to ashlar stone; original night depository intact.
