

Description continued: carved geometric and foliated relief indicative of Art Deco style; chevrons distinguish the base from the walls and beginning of the cornice; on the S. elev., the 7 middle bays project slightly; the 2nd and 8th bays have raised decorated parapets and entry "pediments" have decorative panels; spandrels repeat chevron motif.

Significance continued: composed. Owners First State Bank and Trust occupied this structure until 1965, leasing 2nd floor office space to professionals.

Area of Significance: ARCHITECTURE.


