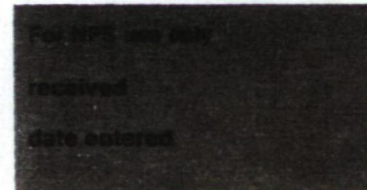

Description continued: porch frieze; interior brick chimney at center and exterior brick chimney w/ corbeled caps; garage; gabled additions to rear; kicked eaves in gable ends; despite application of asbestos siding on side elevations, this is one of Bryan's oldest dwellings; still retains integrity. Significance continued: J.B. Leonard owned the property on which the house sits in the 1880s and 1890s. W.R. Rhodes, the next owner, apparently made improvements to the property (perhaps the major additions onto the rear). The Noto family has owned the house since about 1913. Area of Significance: ARCHITECTURE.
