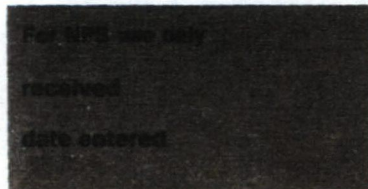
Area of Significance: SOCIAL/HUMANITARIAN (Health/Medicine).

Description continued: elev; and W. elev.; box columns; w/ Ionic capitals; squared-wood balusters; garage; full-height entry portico w/ fluted Ionic columns paired w/ box columns w/ Ionic capitals; gabled dormer w/ Palladian motif centered over portico; bracketed cornice at eaves; polygonal bay w/ cross gable projects from E. elev.; leaded glass in door, sidelights and transom. Significance continued: the paired, giant-order, dissimilar columns are not aligned with the off-center entrance. In 1913 Dr. Oliver is credited as a leader in the founding of Bryan's first hospital. He financed & staffed the hospital on W 28th. It later expanded & in 1954 became St. Joseph's Hospital.
