Description, continued: brick chimney & exterior brick chimney w/ corbeled caps; broken pediment gable surmounts gable on porch; wide overhanging eaves w/ geometric patterning.

Significance continued: This house is one of the most unique, early 20th century houses in McKinney and is representative of how architectural tastes of that period were eclectic. This dwelling incorporates Prairie, bungalow and Queen Anne characteristics which make it one of the most distinctive houses in town.
