Outbuildings include carriage house (contributing). Significance, cont'd: McKinneys most unique and best preserved dwellings. Stephen Heard, who was among the city's most successful merchants of the late 19th and early 20th centuries, was co-owner of the Heard Bros. General Store. He was a director not only of the Collin County National Bank, but also of every major industrial enterprise in McKinney. After his death in 1926, his wife owned the house until her death in 1932. Continued: and her husband Thomas Craig became owners. Katheryn Craig, who died in 1970, bequeathed the house to the "club women of McKinney for cultural and education pursuits." The Heard-Craig Women's Trust maintain ownership to the present and it remains an important social gathering place in McKinney.
