Significance, continued: Few, if any, extant examples display such noteworthy detailing or have remained as unchanged as this dwelling. While this type of house was often simply detailed, this particular structure features a classically detailed entablature with dentils and consoles. The exact date of construction is unknown, but it appears in its present form in an 1881 Bird's Eye View of McKinney. The 1-story rear ell probably predates the 2-story section and was likely the original dwelling. Pioneer merchant John Johnson, a Virginia native, built the house and lived there until his death in 1928.
