Significance continued: the J.R. Nagel Hardware Store which was one of Cuero's first and most important business establishments. The store operated out of the building at 113-15 E. Main Street. Henry Nagel owned the house through the 1930s. Despite alterations, this is one of Cuero's most unusual 19th century houses. Its porch supports w/ molded caps and the slightly pedimented window surrounds are typical of Greek Revival architecture.
