Significance continued: C.H. Griggs as a teacher in the local black school. Daule later became principal of the black high school, serving for about 40 years. The school was later renamed in his honor. In 1948-49 a new black high school (Site No. 762) was built and was named the Daule High School. He is regarded locally as the man most responsible for developing and upgrading Cuero's black schools.
