## DESCRIPTION

Unusual details highlight this small, one-story, frame turn-of-the-century house. Roof is hipped with two prominent cross gables with a curved porch featuring Tuscan columns connecting the two. The projecting, oversized, front-facing gable covers both the columned porch entry and a room with clipped corners. The gables are clapboard with a recessed, shingled, arched form containing pair of 1/1 windows. Entry has oval glazed door. Windows are 1/1 with wide casing. Pier and beam foundation has brick skirting dating from 1978 renovation, but does not detract from an otherwise intact house.

## SIGNIFICANCE

Very attractive, and uniquely detailed example of a small, turn of the century, middle-class dwelling. Built in 1907 for \$800, the owners, J.T. and Minnie McClelland employed contractor A.M. Steger. J.T. McClelland owned a general contracting business in the city. The house was renovated in 1978.

Dear Sir:

It is understood that the office of the State Historic Preservation Officer for the State of Texas is considering nomination of a multiple resources district to the National Register of Historic Places for the City of San Angelo, Tom Green County, Texas. A building located at 100 Paint Rock Road, originally part of the Texas Department of Highways and Public Transportation's District Office in San Angelo which is still used by the Department, is being nominated as a part of this multiple resources district.

The Department wishes to express its opposition to nomination of the building for inclusion within the National Register. The building is not unique and does not meet the criteria for inclusion within the National Register. The building is in public service and is subject to continual alteration as required by operations of the Department. Although the building is in public ownership, it is in the best public interest that this utilitarian, non-commemorative property not be considered for inclusion within the National Register. Consideration for nomination can more appropriately be made at such time as the building is removed from public service.

Your consideration in allowing the opportunity for the Department to express its opposition to nomination of this building in San Angelo for inclusion within the National Register of Historic Places is appreciated.
