Description 1-story frame with drop siding; gable composition roof with extended rafter ends and knee braces; windows are 9/1 wood double-hung with hood molds and decorative surrounds; large exterior brick chimney on west facade; projecting porch supported by large brick columns. The residence is said to have cost \$6,000 when constructed. Interior has beaded ceiling and pine floors; walls have been paneled and some ceilings have drop ceilings, however, these changes are minimal and reversible; original tile bathroom is intact.

12. Significance Excellent bungalow: large bracketed entrance gable is typical of style, but panelled porch beam is a rarity. One of two similar residences owned by the Kennedy brothers, across the street
