

DESCRIPTION 2-story frame dwelling; rectangular plan with a brick pier foundation; wood 1/1 windows; hipped-roof; 1-story, 3-bay attached porch extending across east facade, supported by Tuscan columns resting on brick piers, contained by wood balustrade with square balusters; single door primary entrance with transom is centered under the porch and is flanked by symmetrically placed single windows; majority of remaining windows on both floors are paired; decorative shutters flank windows of the east (front) elevation; exposed rafter ends; exterior brick chimney on north elevation.

Building material: wood frame, clapboard Roof:asphalt Physical condition: good Site:original X moved date Alterations: second floor added in 1925; wood steps to upstairs porch on west (rear) elevation replaced with metal; shed roof; Carport is Non-contributing.

SIGNIFICANCE The Thomas P. Reed House is a good example of a dwelling that underwent extensive, early alterations and yet maintained its residential character. Originally a 1-story hipped-roof cottage, in 1925 it was altered by the addition of the second floor, to accommodate two small apartments. The addition was carried out in a very sympathetic manner and the result was a disparate dwelling type in the Heights.
