DESCRIPTION 1-story frame dwelling; rectangular plan resting on pier and beam foundation; multiple, cross-gabled roof; wood 1/1 windows are arranged in groupings of three on all elevations; exterior brick chimney on north elevation; interior brick chimney extends from the roof; dominant single-door primary entrance on east elevation is offset to the south; Arts and Crafts style door with nine beveled lights, is flanked by sidelights and crowned by elliptical fanlight; entrance is centered under intersecting gable that is supported by triangular knee braces; crowning the entrance is an elliptical canopy.

Building material: wood frame, drop siding Roof:asphalt Physical condition: excellent Site:original X moved date Alterations: screened porch with hipped roof that extends across the west (rear) elevation was added soon after house was built.

SIGNIFICANCE The Glenn W. Morris House is a good example of the Arts and Crafts bungalow style of architecture. Although the house was selected from a catalogue published by a local builder, it is unique in its detailing in comparison to other builder's homes in Houston Heights during the same period. Those elements featured in this house are the multiple, intersecting gables and the asymmetrical balance acheived by the placement of triple windows and embellished entrance.
