DESCRIPTION 1 1/2-story frame dwelling; rectangular floor plan; pier and beam foundation; piers are cast concrete blocks with split-faced quarry appearance; hipped roof with hipped dormers; wide eave overhang with exposed rafters; wood 1/1 windows; full facade 1-story 3-bay inset porch on north elevation; porch supported by tapered box-columns resting on stuccoed piers; turned-wood balustrade and spindled frieze decorate the porch; single-door primary entrance, left of porch center is flanked by single window on the left and paired windows on the right; large, hipped dormers, containing paired windows, on all four slopes of the roof form a cross pattern. Front door has recently (1990) been replaced by a modern paneled unit and fabricated-metal screen outer door.

Building material: wood frame, drop siding Roof: asbestos Physical condition: excellent Site:original X moved date Alterations: sympathetic rear addition in 1980s, using original windows and identical siding.

SIGNIFICANCE The David A. Carden House is an excellent and unique example of an owner-built bungalow in the Houston Heights. Although following certain traditional patterns found in similar designs (ie. hipped roof, dormers, and wide eaves) Mr. Carden borrowed an element from the Victorian styles: the spindled frieze placed along the perimeter of the porch. Echoing this element are the turned-wood balusters. Both assist in making this house a unique statement of owner/builder individuality in the area.
