DESCRIPTION 1-story frame dwelling; asymmetrical plan; masonry pier and beam foundation; hipped roof with four intersecting gables; battered skirt wraps around the house; wood windows feature an Eastlake style 15/1 sash; south gable extends to form front porch; 1-bay porch is supported by two tapered box-columns resting on brick piers; square-wood balusters; single-door primary entrance centered on porch; brick chimney on north elevation; east and west gables cap polygonal bays; knee braces support eaves at each gable; interior brick chimney extends through the roof, above the kitchen. Exterior recently clad with aluminum siding presumably reflecting original pattern.

Alterations: metal covering over wood shingles on roof in 1973;
aluminum siding over exterior in 1976; plate glass over windows in
1979; later, windows added to screened back porch to enclose

SIGNIFICANCE The D.C. McCollum House is a good example of a transitional phase of residential architecture in the Heights. A blend of Victorian detailing and Arts and Crafts bungalow design in a small vernacular dwelling. The bays, gables, and window details of the Victorian period in conjunction with the expansive widths found in the Bungalow style combine in this house to form a distinctive arrangement, uncommon in the Heights.
