The house at 730 North Beal Street is of simple construction based on a common vernacular house form and taking subtle decorative influences from the Greek Revival style. It is a 1-story, side-gabled house with lapped wood siding and rubble limestone foundation and chimneys. It faces east on a large wooded lot in a neighborhood of houses from the late 19th and early 20th centuries.

The house at 730 North Beal is a 1-story frame vernacular dwelling based on a center passage plan with a side gable and an intersecting gable wing addition off of the rear. The foundation of the main house is rubble limestone and the rear wing sits on concrete blocks. The house is clad with wood lap siding and has stone chimneys at the north and south gable ends. The roof is now covered with composition shingles. A modest Greek Revival-influenced porch is centered on the main facade with two boxed columns supporting an entablature and a shed roof. The windows are arranged symmetrically; all are 6/6 double hung wood sash and are capped with a simple hood molding. The house is in good condition with only minor alterations. The house at 730 North Beal, built in the 1870s, is significant as a well-preserved vernacular center passage house common to 19th century Texas communities. Contextually it relates to the Community and Regional Development context, specifically to the growth of Belton during the years of the cattle boom just after the Civil War. The house meets National Register Criterion C, significant in the area of architecture, for embodying the characteristics of an early house type once common to Belton.

This house is believed to have been built during the 1870s, coinciding with the cattle boom in Belton just after the Civil War. The center passage house was a very common dwelling type in 19th century Texas. It was a natural evolution from the earlier dog trot form which incorporated the passage as a hall inside the house, flanked by the two major rooms. Additional rooms were commonly added later on the rear of the house. With its Greek Revival-influenced front porch, 730 North Beal is a good illustration of the way in which vernacular builders borrowed from high styles, often resulting in a minimalist interpretation of stylistic details. This type of center passage house was once very common in the region, but most of the structures have been razed or significantly altered; therefore, this house is a significant surviving example of its type.
