Description:

The Jhules Reading House is a modest, 1-story frame, vernacular dwelling with a 2-room plan and a side gable roof. The exterior walls are sheathed in wood siding and the roof is covered with composition shingles. Facing west onto Reading Street, the house is in a residential neighborhood mostly comprised of 1910s and 1920s dwellings. Still used as a private residence, it retains much of its integrity.

The main (west) facade has a small 2-bay porch with a shed roof supported by wood posts. The house once had two single door entrances but only one, with a single light transom, survives. The other has been enclosed but is evident from the rectangular shape and contrasting wood siding on the north half of the main facade. The wood windows have 2/2 lights with vertical muntins. A shed roof extension at the rear of the house is further expanded with a small flat roof section; neither are easily visible from the street and, therefore, do not greatly detract from the building's historic character.

A Contributing outbuilding, a 1-story garage with board and batten construction, is behind the main house. A small frame shed which appears to have been built in about 1950 stands nearby but is Noncontributing.

Statement of Significance:

The Jhules Reading House, built about 1900, is nominated under Criterion C in the area of Architecture, as an outstanding example of early 20th century vernacular architecture in Abilene. This modest dwelling is one of the city's best illustrations of a 2-room plan house. The building is associated with the historic context "The Railroad and Abilene's Development into a Wholesale and Distribution Center in West Texas, 1881-1939." The building is in good condition and retains its integrity.

Most of Abilene's historic houses date to the 1920s and few of the older dwellings have survived with their integrity intact. The Jhules Reading House is one of few vernacular buildings that appears much as it did when originally constructed. A 2-room vernacular dwelling, it is two rooms wide and one room deep and has a side gable roof. Relatively few 2-room houses are extant in Abilene; however, they were quite common during Abilene's early history.

City directories and Sanborn Fire Insurance Company maps note that the street on which this house stands formerly was called Montagne but was renamed Reading Street in about 1915. Presumably, it was named for Mrs. Jhules Reading who lived in the house through the 1930s.
